SAT & ACT Course Registration & Practice

Check individual college websites for each campus of interest to you to find out what their standardized testing policies are for this admissions cycle.

NOTE: The California State University (CSU) and University of California (UC) systems are test-blind, meaning they do not consider standardized test scores for college admissions.

ACT - Registration and test information at https://www.act.org/

Usually given 7 times a year: September, October, December, February, April, June, and July. Deadlines are typically 3-4 weeks prior to the test dates.

SAT - Registration and test information at College Board

Given 7 times a year: March, May, June, August, October, November, and December. Deadlines are typically 2-3 weeks prior to the test dates.
